September 21st and 22nd

Registration: Thursday, September 19 from 6:00 - 8:00 p.m. and Friday, September 20 from 3:00 - 8:00 p.m. in the lobby of City Hall located at the corner of Broadway and Park Streets.

Entry Fee: \$8 per entry. No limit on number of entries. However, no previous entries will be accepted.

Judging: Saturday, September 21.

People's Choice voting ends at 2:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 22.

Categories: Each piece can be entered into only one category. The categories are:

Needle Art - 3 Classes:

Class 1 - Includes Knitting, Crochet, Weaving, Fashion / Fabric

Class 2 - Includes Cross Stitch, Needlepoint, Embroidery, Ribbon Embroidery

Decorating: Includes Floral, Home Décor, Seasonal

Painting: Includes China, Ceramics, Toile

Wood – Small: Includes Hand Carved Originals, Wall Hangings, Accessories, Bird Houses

Wood – Large: Clocks, Furniture, Chests

All Other Crafts: Includes Clay, Dolls, Jewelry / Beading, Paper Craft, Leather, Stained Glass

Category for each entry will be determined by the Show Chair at the time of registration. Entries made from kits cannot be accepted for judging. These items can be registered for display purposes only.

Awards:

Best of Show: \$100.00

People's Choice: \$ 50.00 cash award

1st place: \$ 50.00 cash award and ribbon

2nd place: \$ 25.00 cash award and ribbon

3rd place: Ribbon

NOTE: *In the event that an insufficient number of entries preclude reasonable competition in any category, the Craft Show Committee reserves the right to reduce the number of prizes awarded.*

Awards and Recognition Ceremony: Awards will be presented to the 1st Place, Best of Show and People's Choice winners on the Heartland Stage, located on the west end of Park Street, at 3:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Claim checks are required when picking up entries. Entries can be picked up between 5:00 and 6:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 22.
