Fortunately, we don't have that type of a challenge ahead of us. However, each of us want to pursue better things for our business or organization. Regardless of the size of our goals or commitments,




there is still a price to pay. We must prepare ourselves mentally and take real action to see results. But the upside is we don't always have to do it alone.
