"Protect Your Profession and Your Clients from Fraudulent "Imitations"

Cindi opened her presentation by asking everyone if they had a license and insurance to raise their hands. Very few did. Then she reminded them about their drivers license and car insurance.

About half the audience raised their hand to having a professional license and insurance. She suggested that they put their professional license number on their business cards, brochures, etc. You worked hard for that license and it proves to the consumer that you are legitimate and know your business. If an electrician, plumber, insurance agent, real estate agent, pest control, etc does not have a license, do not hire them. Buyer Beware! For electricians, plumbers, HVAC, mechanical, pest control and many others, IT IS THE LAW to be licensed and insured.

She reminds us to read the contract and not be fooled by such statements as "Veteran Owned", "In God We Trust", etc. Those statements are great but they don't replace the necessary insurance and license. In Texas, you do not need a license to become a handyman. ... However, each city can have its own requirements for a handyman. The only state limitations are that a handyman cannot perform work if it has to do with plumbing, electrical or HVAC in homes.
