FULL OVERNIGHT CLOSURES SCHEDULED ON NORTHBOUND I-35E IN WAXAHACHIE NEXT WEEK

March 21, 2019

Waxahachie, TX - All northbound lanes of Interstate 35E (I-35E) will be closed overnight in Waxahachie on Wednesday, March 27 and Thursday, March 28 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night for the implementation of a traffic switch.

During both nights of the overnight closures, motorists will be detoured at Exit 404 (Lofland Road) and remain on the northbound frontage road, and re-enter the I-35E northbound mainlanes at the next entrance ramp. Expect delays.
