building. The time that you spend to "spruce up" your businesses online




presence will be time well spent and hopefully bring you new clients or customers. Isn't that what it's all about? Look forward to seeing you at the next Chamber luncheon!

#### FULL OVERNIGHT CLOSURES SCHEDULED ON NORTHBOUND I-35E IN WAXAHACHIE NEXT WEEK

March 21, 2019

Waxahachie, TX - All northbound lanes of Interstate35E (I-35E) will be closed overnight in Waxahachie on Wednesday, March 27 and Thursday, March 28 from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. each night for the implementation of a traffic switch.

During both nights of the overnight closures, motorists will detoured at Exit 404 (Lofland Road) and remain on the northbound frontage road, and re-enter the I-35E northbound mainlanes at the next entrance ramp. Expect delays.
