Zoning Requirements (573) 471-2512

All property in the City is zoned as Residential, Commercial, or Industrial. With few exceptions, businesses may not operate in a Residential Zone. Those exceptions include C1 Neighborhood. Before opening a business in Sikeston you should contact the City Code Department to make sure that your business is properly zoned for the intended use.

Building Permits (573) 471-2512

A building permit is required for all alterations, additions, renovations, and construction of all commercial projects. The procedure for obtaining a commercial building permit:

- 1. Complete and submit a permit application
- 2. Submit 1 set of sealed architectural plans, as well as 1 electronic PDF version formatted for large scale printing, project manuals, and storm water management information.
- 3. Include with the plans a cost breakdown of the project.
- 4. Purchase building permit.

Building permits are issued through the City of Sikeston Code Department, 105 E. Center St.

Business License (573) 471-2193

The purpose of the City's business licensing is to provide a registry of businesses in the city and to protect legitimate businesses from unfair competition with businesses operating in violation of federal, state and local laws. The City issues the following business occupational licenses: Merchants - Mowing/Lawncare - Painter - Carnival/Circus - Contractor - Plumber - Itinerant Vendor Handyman - Electrician

The licensing process: Complete and submit a Business license application along with a \$25 inspection fee. Provide a copy of your Missouri Retail Sales License (if applicable). Pass inspection by Building Code Enforcement Officer. Pay license fee based on the type of business. It is the business owner's responsibility to renew the license. Applications are available at www.sikeston.org (or the Collector's office).

Sales Tax Number (314) 877-0177

A city business license is only issued after a state sales tax number, if applicable, is obtained from the Missouri Department of Revenue. Contact local State office at the above number, or visit dor.mo.gov/forms/2643.pdf

State Registration (866) 223-6535

Most companies operating in Missouri must register with the State. Unincorporated businesses must also file if they do business under any title other than the actual name of the owner. Visit www.sos.mo.gov/ for information, or contact the Office of the Secretary of State in Jefferson City at the above number.

Signage (573) 471-2512

The City regulates the size, type, and placement of all business signage. Before deciding on the type of sign (s) you want for your business, contact the City Code Department. All permanent signs require a permit, and must be approved by Code Enforcement.

County Health Department

All eating and/or drinking establishments are required to have a health permit.
