



GLEN ELLYN POLICE RESPOND TO BURGLARY IN PROGRESS (UPDATE #1)

Glen Ellyn, IL - On January 18, 2019, the Glen Ellyn Police Department was notified of a burglary in progress at the combined Taco Bell and KFC Restaurant located at 370 Roosevelt Road. After further investigation, it has been determined that the offender

in this case was inside the business for several hours waiting for the employees to open the restaurant. Additionally, the offender swung a crow bar at the employees while telling them to open the safe. Attached, and below, are images of the offender captured on surveillance cameras.

There was another burglary reported on January 17, 2019 to Flip's Restaurant located at 340 Roosevelt Road. In both cases, the offender entered the businesses after forcing entry to the drive through windows. The Glen Ellyn Police Department is asking local businesses to fortify drive through windows during off hours and ensure surveillance cameras and alarms are functional.
