



Updates to the Village's Sign Code

In recent months, the Village Board approved several business friendly amendments to the Village's sign code. Staff surveyed surrounding communities to ensure that the Village's regulations were comparable to similar municipalities. The research indicated that a few of the Village's regulations were more restrictive than comparable communities and should be adjusted. In addition to creating sign regulations that would assist businesses with additional signage opportunities, several amendments were approved to clarify existing regulations. Below is a list of some of the more notable

changes to the sign code which took effect immediately following adoption by the Village Board.

- 1. Increase the maximum allowable square footage for building signage in the Downtown.
- 2. Exempt lettering and logos on the valance of an awning from the number and surface area requirements of a district.
- **3**. Provide an exemption for balloon displays in the C2 and C3 Commercial Districts similar to the exemption for the C5A and C5B Downtown Districts.
- 4. Allow establishments in the Downtown Districts to have a lighted LED or neon sign

- that says "Open".
- 5. Allow wall signs to be painted on an exterior building wall.
- 6. Exempt murals from the size and number requirements of the district they are located in and require an exterior appearance review subject to staff review and Village Board approval.
- 7. Remove the 100 square foot maximum area a wall sign in the C3, C4, and C6 Commercial Districts provided the sign has no more than 1 square foot of surface area per linear foot of establishment frontage.
- 8. Provide exemptions for gas stations to allow additional signage to be installed on the gas pump canopy and on each individual gas pump.

Room Reservations Now Open at Civic Center

With construction complete at the Village's Civic Center, room rentals are now back open, effective July 1.

Residents and organizations can find the link to the new room rental reservation system on the Village's <u>website</u>. New users will be prompted to create an account before they can reserve a room.



Civic Center rental availability includes the following:

- Clayton Meeting Room on the second floor of the Civic Center. This room accommodates up to 75 people, with the option to choose from three set-up choices.
- Hours are Monday through Thursday 7 a.m. 10:30 p.m.; Friday 7 a.m. 4:30 p.m.; Saturday 8 a.m. 2 p.m.; closed on Sunday.
- Meeting Room 306 on the third floor of the Civic Center. This room accommodates up to 20 people.
- Hours are Monday through Thursday 5 p.m. 10:30 p.m.; Saturday 8 a.m. 2 p.m.; closed on Friday and Sunday.
- Weidner Auditorium on the second floor of the Civic Center. With its primary use for basketball, groups are charged \$15 an hour for the use of the gym.
- Hours are Monday through Thursday 7 a.m. 10:30 p.m.; Friday 7 a.m. 4:30 p.m.; Saturday 8 a.m. 2 p.m.; closed on Sunday.

VILLAGE OF GLEN ELLYN BOARD APPROVES AVERE ON DUANE DEVELOPMENT IN CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT

Glen Ellyn, IL – On July 8, the Glen Ellyn Village Board approved the Planned Unit Development Plan for the Avere on Duane development located on the south side of Duane Street between Melrose Avenue and Prospect Avenue, across the street from the Glen Ellyn Public Library.

The \$20 million development includes a 48-unit luxury apartment building with an underground parking garage and additional surface parking. This transit-oriented development will offer one bedroom, one bedroom with a den, two bedroom, and two bedroom with a den apartments that range in size from approximately 868 square feet to 1,615 square feet. The architecture and unit mix was designed to appeal to a wide range of Glen Ellyn residents including young professionals, empty nesters and relocating families. The

building will be professionally managed and provides amenities such as bicycle storage, pet wash/grooming area and smart home technology.

During the meeting, Village trustees granted approval of the following:

□ An Ordinance approving a Redevelopment Agreement between the Village of Glen Ellyn and Reva Development Acquisitions, LLC which included a financial incentive ranging from \$1.6 to \$3.1 million depending on taxes generated from the project.

□ A Special Use Permit for a Preliminary and Final Planned Unit Development with deviations from the Zoning Code, a Special Use Permit, a Zoning Map Amendment, a Sign Variation and approval of the Exterior Appearance.

The Village Board agreed to a performance based tax incentive agreement to make the project viable. This reimbursement will only occur if the project is completed and if the development generates an increase in property taxes for the TIF District. This development is projected to generate \$400,000 a year in taxes in comparison to the \$40,000 being generated today.

"We are thrilled that the development community continues to invest in Glen Ellyn," said Village President Diane McGinley. "This development meets the comprehensive plan and downtown goals, along with creating more housing diversity, particularly age-in-place housing. In addition, it provides a \$20 million investment in the community that will generate TIF funds short-term and benefit all taxing bodies long-term."

Prior to Village Board approval, plans were unanimously approved by the Village's Plan Commission on June 20. Demolition is expected to begin by late July or early August 2019, with construction commencing soon thereafter.
