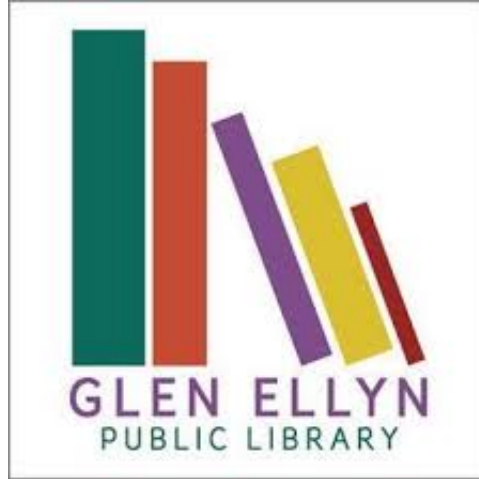

Public Hearing Scheduled for Proposed Avere on Duane Development

Reva Development Partners have submitted an application for the formal review of a Planned Unit Development of a four-story, multi-family development on the south side of Duane Street between Melrose Avenue and Prospect Avenue, across the street from the Glen Ellyn

The proposed development, to be called Avere on Duane, will consist of 48 luxury apartment units with an underground parking garage and a surface parking lot on the south side of the property. The site is comprised of six properties for a total of 1.17 acres.

The Plan Commission will consider the developers' requests at a public hearing on Thursday, June 20, 2019 at 7 p.m. in the Galligan Board Room at the Civic Center, 535 Duane Street. Following the Plan Commission's review, the project is tentatively scheduled for Village Board consideration on Monday, July 8, 2019.



Update to the Village's Comprehensive Plan

The Village is currently in the process of updating its comprehensive plan. Glen Ellyn's existing plan was adopted in 2001. The new plan will act as a blueprint for the Village's future by assessing the community's existing conditions, vision for the future and opportunities for growth. To date, there have been many opportunities for public participation including community surveys, stakeholder meetings, key person interviews, work group meetings and an interactive map-based outreach platform. In addition, several public meetings will be held before the Plan Commission and Village Board prior to the adoption of the new plan.

Public meetings were held in May and June before the Plan Commission and the Village Board to review a draft of the downtown subarea plan which is one section of the future comprehensive plan. Discussions during the meetings included the overall vision for downtown, downtown height limitations and downtown catalyst (possible development opportunity) sites. The downtown sub-area plan was drafted prior to the other subarea plans to allow additional public input on this important Village asset.

To gather further community input, the Village is hosting an open house on June 26 from 4-7 p.m. at the Civic Center to discuss six catalyst sites, including three in the downtown subarea and three in the Roosevelt Road corridor. This will be an informal public forum for the community to interact with the Village's consultants from Houseal Lavigne and Associates and to provide feedback on the proposed concepts that have been developed for the catalyst sites. The sites featured in the draft of the comprehensive plan are simply highlighted as sites that are underutilized where new development might occur. Any of the sites, if redeveloped, could have a positive impact or catalyze other reinvestment opportunities.

Roosevelt Road, Baker Hill Access Improvements



Beginning this summer, access improvements will be made from Roosevelt Road to the Baker Hill Shopping Center as well as southbound access to Pershing Avenue.

Approval on this project was permitted by the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT), who has jurisdiction over Roosevelt Road. Construction is set to begin on the 3/4 access intersection this summer and anticipated to be complete by early fall 2019. The 3/4 access intersection will allow eastbound traffic on Roosevelt Road to make a left hand turn into the shopping plaza and would also allow for westbound traffic on Roosevelt Road to be able to make a left hand turn onto Pershing Avenue.

With Pete's Market anticipated to open this summer in the Baker Hill Shopping Center, the access improvements will increase visibility and access to the entire shopping center



Civic Center Parking Garage and Pedestrian Connection to Main Street

The Village Board is evaluating preliminary design plans for a public parking garage which, if approved, would be located behind the Village's Civic Center at 535 Duane Street. As part of that vision, the Board purchased the building at 423 N. Main Street. In April

2019, the Board approved the first phase of the overall project to include the demolition of the structure on Main Street to create a pedestrian connection from the parking lot behind the Civic Center to Main Street. This improvement will provide better access for customers and employees between the parking lot and businesses in the downtown. Look for the pedestrian connection to begin taking shape in late summer or early fall of this year.

The parking garage, if given final approval by the Board, will provide greater parking opportunities for patrons of the downtown, including the varying needs of commuters, customers and employees
