Last in chance for success-Big Pic.

- •48th in Finance
- 41st in Student Achievement
- •\$5K less on spending per pupil than top tier
- •NAEP scores improving at faster rate than nation
- Last in graduation rate
- •46th in adults fully employed
- Exceeded National growth in all 4 NAEP measures
- •5th in closing the poverty gap in 4th grade-faster than rest of the nation

Douglas-Spring '14 Data

- 74% Students proficient in Reading k-8
- 67% proficient in K-8 mathematics
- 73% proficient K-8 Science
- 90% proficient HS Reading
- 85% proficient in HS Writing
- 89% proficient HS Mathematics
- 89% proficient HS Science
