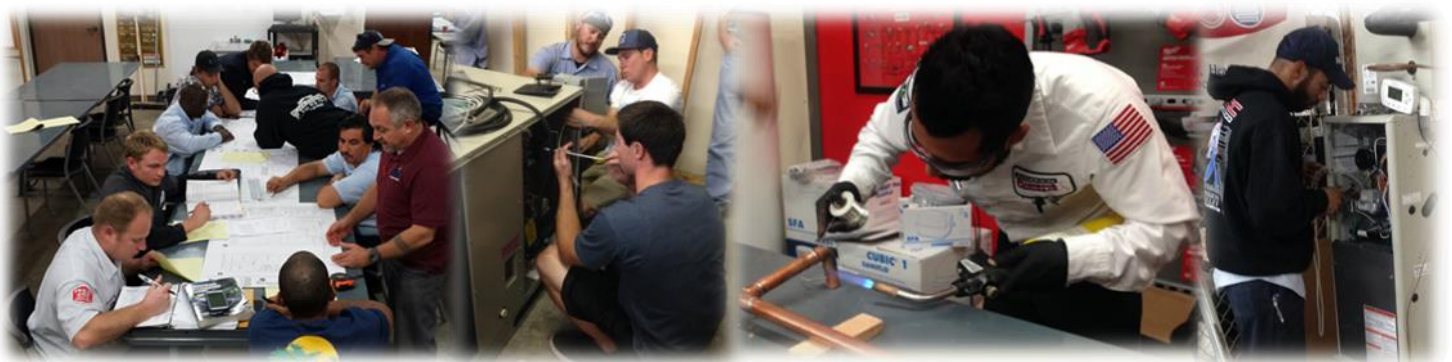

PHCC ACADEMY OF SAN DIEGO TRAINING PROGRAMS

Educated and professional workers are in high demand in the Plumbing Heating Cooling Industry, which currently lacks a robust and skilled workforce. Without training, this problem only increases year upon year. The PHCC helps secure the industry's future so that plumbing and HVAC companies have access to the best in quality technicians to continue to provide quality craftsmanship at competitive prices for the community in which it serves. As time progresses, licensed contractors and consumers recognize the value of skilled professionals and look for the PHCC logo first.

The PHCC Academy of San Diego offers two training programs plus a variety of specialized Continuing Education Programs throughout the year:

JOURNEYMAN PLUMBING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

The Journeyman Plumbing Apprenticeship Program is a four-year program accredited by the Office of Apprenticeship, Department of Labor. Licensed contractors are able to Federally register employees as Apprentices, while they are enrolled in this training program. This program provides 156 hours of classroom instruction plus hands-on labs over four years. Curriculum include safety, state and local code and regulations, mathematics, drafting and blueprint reading. This Program gives technicians a thorough knowledge of all aspects of the plumbing trade. By the end of their fourth year, Apprentices will have clocked annually 8000 hours of on-the-job training, more than 600 hours of classroom and hands-on learning, and are given the chance to take the California PHCC Journey Level Certification Exam to ultimately earn their well-deserved PHCC Journeyman Card.

HVAC TECHNICIAN TRAINING PROGRAM

Increasing development of HVAC (heating and air-conditioning systems) technology causes employers to recognize the importance of continuous education and the development of the latest equipment. Our certificate program is **North American Technician Excellence (NATE)** recognized with theoretical and practical skills to prepare HVAC installers and technicians to master the HVAC Technician National Craft Assessment and Certification Exams.

CLASS SCHEDULE & CURRICULUM

- Students attend class one evening per week.
- Some courses require pre-scheduled Saturday hands-on labs.
- Students must attend all classes and follow protocol for make-up hours and attendance
- For optimal learning, class size is limited to 20 students.
- Our curriculum follows data from the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER) for Craft Trades
- Training program employs skilled and experienced industry professionals as instructors.
- Industry experts and manufacturer representatives demonstrate cutting-edge products and technology, and may provide manufacturing certifications at various stages in the curriculum.

JOURNEYMAN PLUMBING APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM

PLUMBING FIRST YEAR

Introduction to the plumbing trade, history and careers, common plumbing tools and materials, tool safety, trade mathematics, related sciences, introduction to blue print reading and sketching, fixture and fitting identification. Introduction to basic plumbing codes requirements, occupation safety practices and procedures, first aid, customer service and installation practices.

Tuesdays — 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

Some Saturday Labs Required—total of 5 from 8am-5pm. Schedule to be posted September 2018

PLUMBING SECOND YEAR

Service and Repair problems and solutions, basic electricity and applications, residential and commercial fixtures installation, local UPC code applications, water, waste, gas, systems, job safety, review of customer relations, math, hands-on applications of commercial, residential, industrial and new construction. Introduction to welding, ladders and scaffolds, plumbing vents and sewage pumps.

Wednesday — 5:30 p.m. – 8:30 p.m.

Some Saturday Labs Required—total of 5 from 8am-5pm. Schedule to be posted September 2018

PLUMBING THIRD YEAR

Isometric drawing, plan reading, sizing water, sizing gas, and sizing waste and vent. Installation practices both commercial and residential, tool use and methods, water heaters and venting blueprint and specifications, job pre-planning, productivity and profitability.

PLUMBING FOURTH YEAR

BOOK REQUIREMENTS

Journeyman Plumbing Apprenticeship Program

Curriculum is based on the National Center for Construction Education & Research (NCCER) four-year series of plumbing textbooks, and the International Association of Plumbing & Mechanical Officials (IAPMO) Uniform Plumbing Code Book, 2015 Edition. Each student is required to obtain the required textbook and Code Book (Illustrated or Non-Illustrated) for the current year of enrollment. All books are available through the PHCC Academy of San Diego, or are available online.

HVAC TECHNICIAN CERTIFICATION PROGRAM

HVAC FIRST YEAR

Introduction to systems and major components, basic electricity, thermodynamics, basic refrigeration cycle, scheduled maintenance, systematic problem solving, basic installation and repair methods, compressors, refrigerants and lubrication, condensers, metering devices, refrigeration accessories, evaporators, evacuation and charging procedures.

Universal EPA 608 Refrigerant Certification.

HVAC SECOND YEAR

Heating, electrical, electrical troubleshooting, introduction to motors, cooling equipment, mechanical troubleshooting, advanced installation techniques, control systems, psychrometrics and basic sizing, servicing and troubleshooting systems, TAB, energy efficient mechanical systems, fluid handling systems, applied electrical problem solving, applied refrigeration system problem solving, troubleshooting with the psychrometric chart, cooling towers and evaporative condenser, commercial air conditioning and refrigeration systems, indoor air quality, energy efficient installations & selling and customer service. ICE Certification.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age at the time of enrollment.
- Applicants to Journeyman Plumbing Apprenticeship Program must be employed by a company with a valid California Plumbing License (C-36) throughout the program (*not a requirement of the HVAC training program*).
- Applicants must pass Entrance Exams with 70% score, and participate in an interview with training committee.
- All fees listed above and in Statement of Financial Responsibility are due by first class, or a student may not participate in class activities.

ENTRANCE EXAM

New Applicants must pass (2) Entrance Exams each with a 70% score: Reading Comprehension and Math Essentials

TO APPLY

Application must be submitted to PHCC Academy of San Diego office with the following by first night of class:

- Signed Application, including Statement of Financial Responsibility and Registration Form, with all portions completed for each enrolled student;
- First (2) months of tuition payment (*full tuition payment receives 10% discount*);
- All applicable administration and entrance exam fees as listed above

** Advanced Placement in Plumbing Year 2 or Plumbing Year 3 Apprenticeship Program is available with strict qualifications. Please ask for detailed information from our admissions staff.*

*** Required books may be purchased thru the PHCC Academy of San Diego or online. Please review the book list as provided by our admissions staff. Books must be brought to class and are the sole responsibility of the student.*

REFUND & FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY POLICIES — PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

If student drops from program, PHCC Academy continues to charge tuition until written notice from Financially-Responsible party is received, at which time current month student drops will be charged and remaining tuition will be cancelled. 1. Financially Responsible Party is obligated for the payment of tuition and fees associated with the 2018-2019 Training Program regardless of student attendance.
2. Fees are due no later than the first night of class via cash, check or credit card: First two months of Tuition Payments + Application Processing Fees + application Entrance Exam Fees.
3. Book fees are billed separately upon order. Students may purchase books through the Academy or online as long as the title of the book and version match identically to the Course Curriculum,
4. Monthly invoices are sent via email on the first of every month.
5. We provide a 10-day grace period for all monthly tuition payments. A late fee of \$35 is automatically assessed on the 11th of every month that tuition remains unpaid.
6. In the event a student drops from the program regardless of reason, a written notice must be received by the financially-responsible party, at which time the current month the student drops will still be charged. No refunds are given after the first of the month, regardless of the date the student leaves the program, and no refunds are given for any prepaid tuition.
7. For accounts 30 days past due, student is suspended and letter is issued to financially-responsible party. Student is not permitted to class until full payment is received. Valid credit card must remain on file for payments thereafter. Continuous non-payment of tuition + fees result in cancellation of student enrollment and withholding of services, certifications and grades until financial liabilities are resolved.
