



Plumbing Journeyman Apprenticeship Program Advanced Placement Requirements

No transfers or schedule changes after third week of class. Apprentices not attending first three classes are dropped from program.

Plumbing Apprenticeship Program - Year 2

- Equivalent to 2000 hours or (1) year full-time work with a licensed plumbing contractor (must provide copy of W-2s) *
- Letter of recommendation from current or former supervisor(s)
- Pass Plumbing Year 1 Placement Exam with 80% grade or better
- Active OSHA-10 or OSHA-30 Certification Card **
- Board member interview and approval
- Pass Basic Entrance Exams with 70% or greater on each exam:
 - o Basic English Comprehension at 9th grade level
 - o Basic Mathematics at 8th grade level
- First (2) tuition payments due with application
- All other student tuition, fees and requirements apply

Plumbing Apprenticeship Program - Year 3

- Completion of PHCC Year 1 Plumbing Apprenticeship Program or board-approved equivalent Year 1 apprentice program
- Equivalent to 4000 hours or (2) years full-time work with a licensed plumbing contractor (must provide copy of W-2s) *
- Letter of recommendation from current or former supervisor
- Pass Plumbing Year 2 Placement Exam with 80% grade or better
- Active OSHA-10 or OSHA-30 Certification Card **
- Board member interview and approval
- Pass Entrance Exams with 70% or greater on each exam
 - Basic English Comprehension at 9th grade level
 - Basic Mathematics at 8th grade level
- Pass Plumbing Year 2 Placement Exam with 80% or greater
- First (2) tuition payments due with application
- All other student tuition, fees and requirements apply

^{*} If you have worked for more than one contractor for the required 2000 hours, you must show proof of all W-2s and/or provide a letter of recommendation from the owner of the company you worked for previously.

^{**} OSHA-30 is included in the PHCC Academy of San Diego Plumbing Year 1 Course. If you are not OSHA-10 Certified (minimum) but meet all other qualifications for Advanced Placement, you must achieve OSHA-10 or OSHA-30 Certification within six months of admission. The PHCC Association of San Diego offers OSHA-10 Certification Training a few times during the year.
