Even after controlling for severity and other measures workers with an initial visit for the injury to a surgeon had almost 9 times the odds of receiving lumber spine surgery, compared to those seeing a primary care provider, whereas workers whose first visit was to a chiropractor had significantly lower odds of surgery."6

Paid costs for episodes of care initiated with a DC were almost 40% less than episodes initiated with an MD. Even after risk adjusting each patient's cost, we found that episodes of care initiated with a DC were 20% less expensive than episodes initiated with an MD.⁷
