The **12TH** Annual Big Lake Dog Vaccination Clinic will be held Saturday, Sept. 9, 2017 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon at Lions Community Park, 21960 County Road 5 (garage). Barrington Oaks Veterinary Hospital, Elk River, will provide vaccination services at this event.

<u>All dogs must be on a leash.</u> Only healthy dogs will be vaccinated. A Dog License is required to be eligible for the discounted vaccinations. The \$10.00 license fee is valid for two (2) years.

City and Big Lake and Township residents will be able to purchase a dog license on site the day of the event.
