each vehicle they buy to ensure customer satisfaction. Their lot includes many late-model vehicles


with remaining factory warranty!

Our Secretary of State office reports that Minnesota was #1 in voter turn-out in 2016. We can do our part to keep that record in 2018 by being informed about the candidates and voting on Tuesday, November 6th.

# Congressman Tom Emmer receives US Chamber award

The Chamber's prestigious Spirit of Enterprise Award is given annually to members of Congress based on their votes on critical business legislation as outlined in the Chamber's How They Voted scorecard (<a href="https://www.uschamber.com/how-they-voted/2017">https://www.uschamber.com/how-they-voted/2017</a>).



Members who supported the Chamber's position on at least 70 percent of those votes qualify to receive the award. Congressman Emmer received 93% ranking on key business votes while MN US Senators received less than 30% This is the 30th year that the U.S. Chamber has formally honored the accomplishments of this select group of members of Congress.

Congressman Emmer received this award at the St. Cloud Chamber on August 29th.

# 4th Annual Kids' Photography Contest Focus on: Sherburne National Wildlife Refuge


Submission Deadline: October 6, 2018



Step 4: Individuals bike to more places more often. Businesses see more bike traffic, increased customer loyalty amongst bike riding customers and instantly become a bikefriendly establishment through participation.
