- 4.) Applicant has no felony convictions.
- 5.) Applicant is a legal US resident.
- 6.) Knowledgeable about the Airmen Association, student or basic membership preferred.

#### **Selection Criteria**

Scholarships will be awarded weighted on each of the following:

- 1.) Commitment to aviation goals
- 2.) Interest in general and commercial aviation in Alaska
- 3.) Evidence of financial need
- 4.) Personal and career goals
- 5.) Other criteria as determined by the scholarship committee
