TAXES

LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX: Sales and use taxes levied in Lafayette total 8.485%. This total is comprised of 3.50% levied by the City of Lafayette, 2.90% levied by the State of Colorado, 1.100% for Regional Transportation and 0.985% for Boulder County.

LOCAL PROPERTY TAX: Taxes on residential and commercial property are levied against a taxable or "assessed" value. Residential assessment is 10% of assessed value and commercial assessment is 29% of assessed value. In Lafayette, an annual property tax of 86.030 mills (\$1.00 of tax per \$1000 of assessed value) is levied on real and personal property. The following example illustrates the calculation of property taxes. A \$300,000 house would have a taxable or assessed value of \$30,000 (\$300,000 X 10%) X 86.030 mills or about \$2580 in annual taxes.
