By sharing and understanding each other's wants, needs, struggles and victories all of South County's organizations can work together to present a strong and unified voice on South County related issues.

Security Tips for the Workplace

There is a perception that Workplace Violence comes out of nowhere within a business that has traditionally been safe with minimal security training. The truth is there are many warning signs that have gone unrecognized in most violent workplace incidents.

- When terminating an employee for disciplinary issues, the employer, a witness, and security personnel should be present. If there are ANY warning signs suggesting threatening behavior, law enforcement needs to be contacted.
- Domestic violence has often entered the workplace. Helping resolve these situations can save lives. Interviews and coordination with HR is crucial.
- A disgruntled employee who displays concerning behavior over politics or religion can lead to hate crimes.
 Be aware of employees who display these uncontrolled outbursts of anger. Gain understanding by observation and interviews of what level of disturbance this employee is experiencing. This will give you insight to recognize potential danger. Hatred and anger in the workplace should be taken seriously.

With the above data, HR or your Security Officer will be in a position to take the next needed precautionary action. Stay alert and united to increase your workplace safety.
