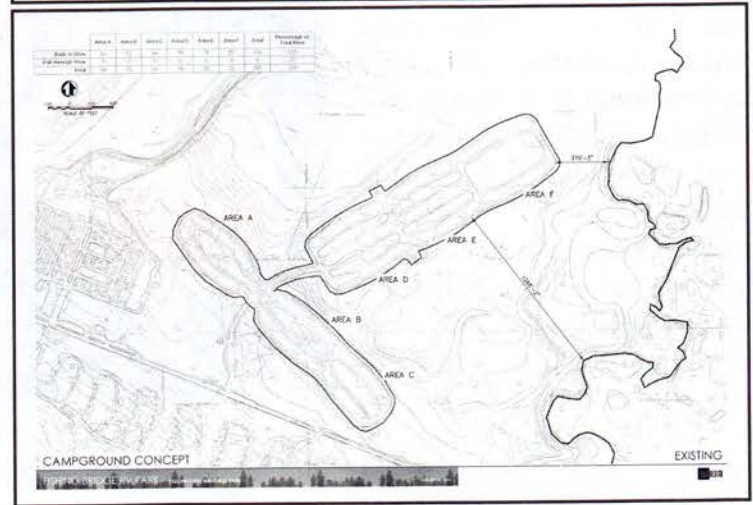
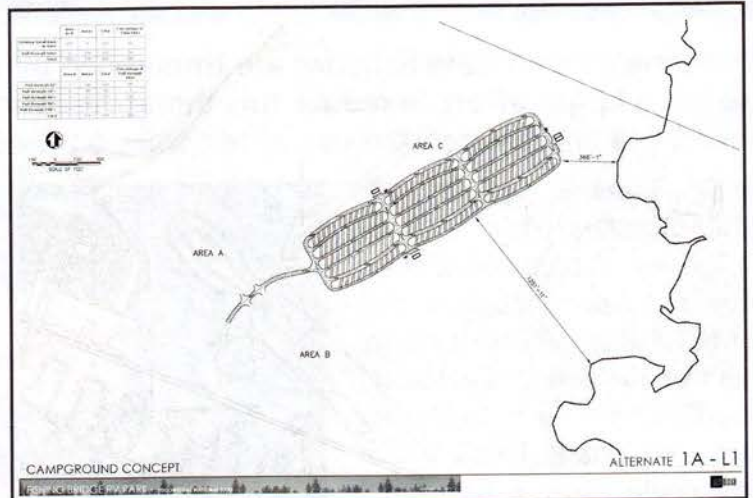


A complete renovation of the Fishing Bridge RV park will begin in September of 2018.

FISHING BRIDGE RV PARK RENOVATION



This project will redesign the RV Park within the existing footprint.

As part of the Concessions Facility Improvement Program (CFIP), the Fishing Bridge RV park is being renovated beginning fall of 2018. The renovation will expand the size of the sites with pull through sites in Area C to allow for modern vehicles. The total RV Park sites will go from 358 to 328. Improvements will also be made to the Camper Service Building increasing its size and stabilizing the existing structure. In addition, water, sewer, and electrical infrastructure

and hook-ups will be replaced. Four existing comfort stations will be renovated.

The estimated cost for this work is \$18 million with CFIP funds provided by Xanterra Parks & Resorts. Xanterra will close the RV park after Labor Day, 2018 and it will continue to be closed for all of 2019.

The Fishing Bridge General Store and Fishing Bridge Service Station will also be closed after Labor Day, 2018. They will be open for the 2019 summer season.



Improvements made to the 3.5-mile section of the East Entrance Road between Fishing Bridge and Indian Pond this year will benefit visitors traveling in this popular corridor.

Anticipate delays if your travel plans include visiting the park from the East Entrance. The road will be under construction the entire seasons of 2018 and 2019.

Road re-construction efforts will finish widening the last 3.5 miles of the East Entrance Road. The entire East road will be widened to a modern template of 30' wide (4' shoulder, 11' lane, 11' lane and 4' shoulder).

The reconstruction effort will improve entry and exit points into developed areas, provide for better scenic viewing opportunities along the road and improve parking at trailheads and turnouts. In addition, repairs to the historic Fishing Bridge will extend the life of the iconic bridge.

The East Entrance Road to Fishing Bridge and Lake is scheduled to open to the public May 4, weather permitting. Visitors should expect 30-minute delays between Fishing Bridge and Indian Pond (excluding Memorial Day, Independence Day, and Labor Day weekends).

From October 15 through November 5, 2018, the road between Sedge Bay and Fishing Bridge will be closed. During the closure, the East Entrance Road will remain open from the entrance to Sedge Bay, weather permitting.

Visitors traveling to and from Cody will need to use the Northeast Entrance during this closure. Tower Fall to Canyon (Dunraven Pass) traditionally closes on October 9. Depending on weather, staff may keep it open after October 9 to allow for an additional route to and from Cody via the Northeast Entrance.
