Organization

Objective

This person will share responsibility for ensuring Connext is fiscally responsible, recruiting and developing other Board Members, and establishing policies and procedures for effective management and growth of our organization.

Responsibilities

- Understand and promote Connext's mission; be an ambassador for Connext in your work and in the community
- Keep current on nonprofit issues and topics of interest
- Attend board meetings and engage in discussion regarding organization policies, goals, and effectiveness
- Share ideas for events and programming that will interest and serve our members
- Contribute to the planning and execution of a minimum of two events each year
- Participate in Connext events, supporting your team in set up, tear down, and engaging attendees
- Support the recruitment of new Board Members by discussing Connext with other passionate young professionals
- Be a good steward of all Connext money and resources

Expectations

- Commit to a two year term
- Attend monthly board meetings, missing no more than 4 each year 1.5 hours each month
- Serve on a minimum of one committee
- Participate in at least six Connext events each year 12 hours each year
- Engage in regular committee meetings 1 hour each month
- Attend new member orientation 1.5 hours
