



**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE PASSAGE OF THE
2018 WAKE COUNTY PARKS, RECREATION, AND OPEN SPACE BOND**

WHEREAS, a Wake County parks, recreation, and open space bond question will be on the November 6, 2018 ballot asking voters to authorize the issuance of \$120 million in bonds for improving and expanding existing parks and recreational facilities and acquiring open space and constructing new parks, and recreational facilities; and

WHEREAS, rapid growth in Wake County has created continued demands for preservation of current and future natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the parks, recreation, and open space options positively impact the quality of life of Wake County citizens; and

WHEREAS, the Wake County Open Space program, which strives to protect water quality through targeted land acquisition, has protected over 4,700 acres of land across Wake County; and

WHEREAS, general obligation bonds represent the most economical alternative with which to fund this critical need and are a responsible investment in the region's future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Morrisville Chamber of Commerce hereby supports the passage of the 2018 Wake County Parks, Recreation, and Open Space bonds for the betterment of Wake County.
