



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS (FAQ)

1. How do I become a CBIA PWB member?

You can download a membership application on our website or request one from cbiapwb@gmail.com. Complete the form and follow instructions on submitting the application and payment information. Our membership chairs will notify you once the application is received and approved by NAHB.

2. Do I need to be a member of a local PWB chapter first?

Yes, if your company is within the jurisdiction of PWB of the Bay Area or PWB of Fresno/Madera, then you need to apply first with your local PWB chapter. If your company is not within the region of these two chapters, then you can apply directly to CBIA PWB.

3. What do I get with my CBIA PWB membership?

By joining CBIA PWB, you get to lend your voice to our council's legislative advocacy, educational outreach, and advancement of women in the California building industry. You also receive valuable networking and business development opportunities at our highly anticipated annual events and membership to the NAHB (national) PWB chapter.

4. How much does a CBIA PWB membership cost?

Membership is \$80 per person, due annually. You will be notified of your upcoming renewal date by CBIA PWB.

5. When does the council hold meetings?

All members calls, which includes members from local PWB chapters, are held on the first Tuesday of each month from 1-2pm, PST. In-person meetings are held twice a year at the fall and winter CBIA Governance Meetings.
