Emerson Creek Wind, a wind energy project located in Erie and Huron Counties:

Preliminary plans show that Emerson Creek may include between 66-71 wind turbines placed on land leased from participating landowners that could produce approximately 300 MW of electricity. This is enough safe, pollution-free, home-grown energy to power up to 85,000 homes in our region.
