#### ■ FROM THE DESK OF THE DIRECTOR

I had an opportunity to attend the first ever Iowa Retail Summit put on by Iowa State University Extension and Outreach in Ames a week ago. The intent was to examine the data that has been collected and the lessons learned about what it takes to have vibrant downtowns in our communities. One key idea is to meld the various smaller "communities" that lie within the greater city limits. A good example of this was "Junkin in June", an idea crafted in the past few years by antiques, re-purposed or upcycling retailers and consignors. Initially its appeal was to the antique collector, bargain hunter or artisan, but now encompasses a wide variety of consumer interests...and by the looks of the people milling around downtown Boone last week, is one of the hottest trends in retail these days. But 'Junkin' was more than a sale. It was an event that filled the stores, sidewalks and vacant lot at 8<sup>th</sup> street with an energy no ordinary weekend traffic can muster. The cooperation between the stores and mobile vendors, the city of Boone, the Chamber and others, is a prime example of the little communities coming together for the good of the whole. These types of events are growing, and several of our member businesses have plans in the making for more of the same this year, including what might be the biggest Crazy Day in recent memory. If you and your business get a chance to participate in these opportunities, I encourage you to get creative, join in and watch your downtown come back to life. The data you generate will likely come from your cash register.

Currently, the Park Board, Library Board and Planning and Zoning Board are all in need of additional members. 
