

3. Team up - Find some other local businesses and team up to make a great value pack for guests this summer.





COMMUNITY UPDATES



June in Ogden is all about getting ready for, and celebrating Ogden Fun Days. This year's celebration takes place from June 27th through the 29th with a theme of "Have a Yabba Dabba Doo Time"! Anthony Koester and Exit 185 headline the entertainment on Friday and Saturday night's respectively. Main street has seen a nice contingent of new businesses pop up over the past year, and now includes The New Moon Mercantile at 325 W. Walnut. Deb Miller and Carol Christensen are the entrepreneurs behind the boutique gift shop.



An empty lot now greets traffic along State Highway 17 in Madrid as the former Pizza Palace building has been torn down immediately across from Casey's General Stores. There are no plans to locate a new business there and the lot will remain a greenspace. The Boone County Trails Initiative was recently awarded a \$100,000 grant from the Central Iowa Regional Transportation Planning Alliance for FY 2021. The money is targeted toward constructing an approximately 1.5 mile path leading from the High Trestle Trail along QF Lane up to Swede Point County Park, and is the first phase of an overall 16 mile trail alignment that will connect the HTT to the city of Boone.




