Governor

- a. Serve as the governing body of the Commercial Brokers Association.
- b. Become familiar with the programs of the Corporation and its governance.
- c. Approve new policies and procedures as needed.
- d. Be aware of the goals and objectives established by the Board and Officers, and serve in the best interest of the Association to meet those goals and objectives
- e. Approve the annual budget.

Chairperson-Elect

- a. Collaborate with the Chairperson to learn the role of the Chairperson
- b. Become familiar with the programs of the Corporation and its governance
- c. In coordination with the CEO and CFO, plan and conduct the annual Strategic Planning meeting.
- d. Carry out special projects and assignments as assigned by the Chairperson.
- e. Assist and support the Chairperson as needed.
- f. Plan for the Chairperson year. Automatically become Chairperson at the end of the term as Chairperson-Elect.
- g. In coordination with the CFO, monitor the Association's budget and make reasonable efforts to adhere to it.



Committee Volunteer

- a) Serve on a Board Committee established by the Board of Governors.
- b) Meet quarterly and at the call of the Committee Chair. Regular attendance is expected of all committee members.
- c) Review, research and make recommendations to the Board of Governors on issues assigned to the Committee.

Task Force Volunteer

- d) Serve on a Task Force established by the Board of Governors.
- e) Meet as needed, at the call of the Task Force Chair..
- f) Review, research and make recommendations to the Board of Governors on assigned tasks.
